Exhibitor's Guide & Prize List

Entries will be accepted on Thursday, August 6th from 4pm-6pm.

Entry forms will be available to print at the end of this guide or will be available at drop off.

EXHIBITOR'S RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Entries will only be accepted in the allotted time during the week of Harvey Community days**
- 2. The entry fee is \$5 per adult exhibitor, \$3 per child (for up to 6 entries, additional entries are \$1 each).**
- 3. All entries must be listed on the printed forms provided at the end of this manual. If form is missing or if additional forms are needed, they can be picked up during drop off times or can be printed from our website <https://harveycommunitydays.com/index.html#/>**
- 4. The exhibitor must have personally produced the item(s) to be entered.**
- 5. All items must have a tag attached with the section, class and exhibitor's number clearly displayed. These tags are provided when entries are accepted.**
- 6. Only one item per class, per exhibitor will be accepted.**
- 7. Judging will be completed by 10am on Saturday, August 8th. Exhibits will be on display Saturday, August 8th for the duration of the carnival.**
- 8. Any exhibitor wishing to sell any article may attach a price tag (limited to non-edible entries)**
- 9. All exhibits must stay on the grounds until Saturday, August 8th, until the end of the carnival. Exhibits are to be picked up between 2-3pm on Saturday.**
- 10. Safety of exhibits: The Harvey Community Network will take every reasonable precaution to keep exhibits safe, but exhibitors display their articles at their own risk.**
- 11. Prizes will be paid during pick up on Saturday, August 8th.**
- 12. All entries of preserves, canning, etc. will be opened for judging.**
- 13. No entry shall be given a prize simply because it is the only entry in the class. Therefore, just because a particular prize is offered does mean it has to be awarded without merit. Prizes are awarded based on excellence.**

Do not wash vegetables, simply brush off excess soil. When selecting vegetables, pay attention to uniformity of size and shape. Produce should be displayed on a plate/tray/etc. strong enough to support its weight.
